What is exempt from sales taxes in Massachusetts?

Many states have special sales tax rates that apply to the purchase of certain types of goods, or fully exempt them from the sales tax altogether. Here's how Massachusetts taxes five types of commonly-exempted goods:

Are services subject to sales tax in Massachusetts?

"Goods" refers to the sale of tangible personal property, which are generally taxable. "Services" refers to the sale of labor or non-tangibles. In Massachusetts, specified services are taxable. Local Sales Taxes in Massachusetts

Unlike many other states, Massachusetts doesn't allow municipal governments to collect a local option sales tax. Therefore, sales tax rates will be the same across the entire state.
